PRIEST: (John 14, 1-6)

Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God and faith in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places otherwise how could I have told you that I was going to prepare a place for you, and then I shall come back to take you with me, that where I am you also may be. You know the way that leads where I go." "Lord," said Thomas, "we

do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?"

Jesus told him: "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through me." (This is the gospel of the Lord.)

ALL: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

ALL: (Response – Psalm 22)

I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in me, even if he die, shall live; and whoever lives and believes in me shall never die.

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want:

He makes me lie down in green pastures.

He leads me besides still waters;

He restores my soul.

He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,

I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;

You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows.

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

PRIEST: Lord, may the prayers of your people be heard on behalf of the faithful departed. Forgive them the debt of their sins, and make them sharers in the redemption. This we ask through Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

PRIEST: Let us pray together the Our Father:

ALL: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name! Thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

(Priest sprinkles the casket with holy water)

PRIEST: The Lord be with you.

ALL: And also with you.

PRIEST: Let us pray. Lord God, for three days the body of your Son lay resting in the tomb, awaiting the resurrection, and making holy the graves of all who believe in you. As the body of N.......... is placed in this sacred ground, may the hope of the resurrection fill the hearts of your faithful. Grant peace to your servant as his/her body rests here, awaiting the call of your Son to share in the full light of your presence and the everlasting joy of the kingdom. Through Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

PRIEST: Eternal rest grant to him/her, O Lord,

ALL: And let perpetual light shine upon him/her.

PRIEST: May he/she rest in peace.

ALL: Amen.

PRIEST: May his/her soul and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace.
